

Sliding Fee Scale

A patient can be eligible for this program if they do not have insurance, are under-insured or has a high deductible. To qualify for this program you must complete the sliding fee application. If you need assistance in completing the application or have questions please call for an appointment with the office manager at the location you wish to be seen. The sliding Fee Program, based on income and family size, offers a discounted rate on medical and dental services offered at any of our facilities.

Eligibility/Income/Household Status: The patient must meet the income margins set by the federal poverty guidelines. To provide evidence of income, the patient or guarantor will have to present a copy of their most recent federal tax return and pay stubs if requested. If a federal tax return is not available or if there has been a change in financial status, the patient / guarantor must submit a statement of financial status.

Types of Eligible Income will include but is not limited to:

- Employment: Check stubs for the last 30 days.
- Federal Income Tax Return: W-2 and a copy of the most recent federal income tax return.
- Unemployment: unemployment check stub or computer printout from the employment office.
- Child Support/Alimony: Computer print out from child support office
- TANF: Copy of check or other document from the County Division of Family Resources and Department of Child Services (DFR/DCS Offices)
- SSI or Disability: Check stub or automatic deposit slip or bank statement
- Pension/Retirement: Statement of benefits from previous employer or statement from bank or investment firm.
- Trust/Endowment: Bank statement
- Scholarship/Grants: Letter of award
- Union Sub Pay: Check Stub

Include all persons in the household and all income supporting those persons.
